Luisa Peirano holds a PhD in Public Communications from the University of Navarre and a B.A. from the Catholic University of Buenos Aires. In 2004, she was awarded a Fulbright scholarship to do research at Columbia University's Journalism School, where she worked with novelist Sylvia Nasar, author of "A Beautiful Mind". In 2009, she won the Hubert Humphrey Award, to study Public Relations and Leadership at the University of Maryland's Journalism School. She has participated in Leadership and Communication Seminars at Harvard University and the University of Navarre.

In 1998, she was one of the representatives of Uruguay in the UNESCO's Higher Education Conference in Paris. In 2004, she set up the Office of International Affairs of the Universidad de Montevideo. As director she is committed to international education and to developing global citizens and leaders to promote worldwide understanding of Latin America.

Dr. Peirano has published and edited books and articles in Uruguay, Argentina, and the United States. In 2017 she translated *Clandy*, an unpublished novel of Sir Geoffrey Jackson, British Ambassador to Uruguay in the 1960s. She also published the *Indice Complexivo de los Cuadernos de Marcha* (Montevideo: El Galeón, 2013); *Tristán Narvaja, un jurista rioplatense en tiempos de la codificación* (Buenos Aires: 2008); *Ramón Díaz and the spread of liberal ideas in Uruguay* (New York: *The Freeman*, 2004); "*El primer periodo de los Cuadernos de Marcha*" en *Marcha y America Latina* (Pittsburgh University, 2003); *Marcha de Montevideo* (Buenos Aires: Vergara, 2001), and *El Valor del Ejemplo (The Value of the Example)* (Montevideo, Unión Latina, 1994). She has also been member of assessment committees of doctoral thesis.
